## 9<sup>th</sup> IQAM CONSENSUS CONFERENCE

**IQAM**, the IPRAS International Committee for Quality Assurance, Medical Devices and Technologies in Plastic Surgery, organized the **9<sup>th</sup> biennial IQAM Consensus Conference** in **Bratislava**, Slovakia on **September 23-26, 2010**.

**IQAM**, the International Committee for Quality Assurance, Medical Technologies and Devices in Plastic Surgery is a professional data-generating medical and scientific organization committed to the task of actively researching existing and new technologies in plastic surgery. Also, **IQAM** is dedicated to the assurance of the safe use of medical devices, technologies and procedures in plastic surgery, as well as to ensuring patients safety.

**IQAM** reviews and evaluates updated literature, studies and scientific data, recommends standards of treatment for new devices and technologies, and evaluates potentially deleterious use of products, devices and technologies, or their application for unintended or unsuitable indications.

At the close of the Conference, a Consensus Declaration was drawn up summarizing the conclusions of the Conference, and was presented to health ministries plastic surgery societies and health and medical agencies of the individual member countries.

The interaction between physicians, scientists and manufacturers prior to and during the implementation of new technologies is essential in order to ensure the safety of these technologies in clinical use. It is imperative that **IQAM** continues its vigilance and scientific evaluation of both old and new technologies, devices and surgical procedures, for the assurance of safety procedures.

In parallel, the 1st meeting of CEN/TC 403 was held along with the 9th IQAM Consensus conference in Bratislava.

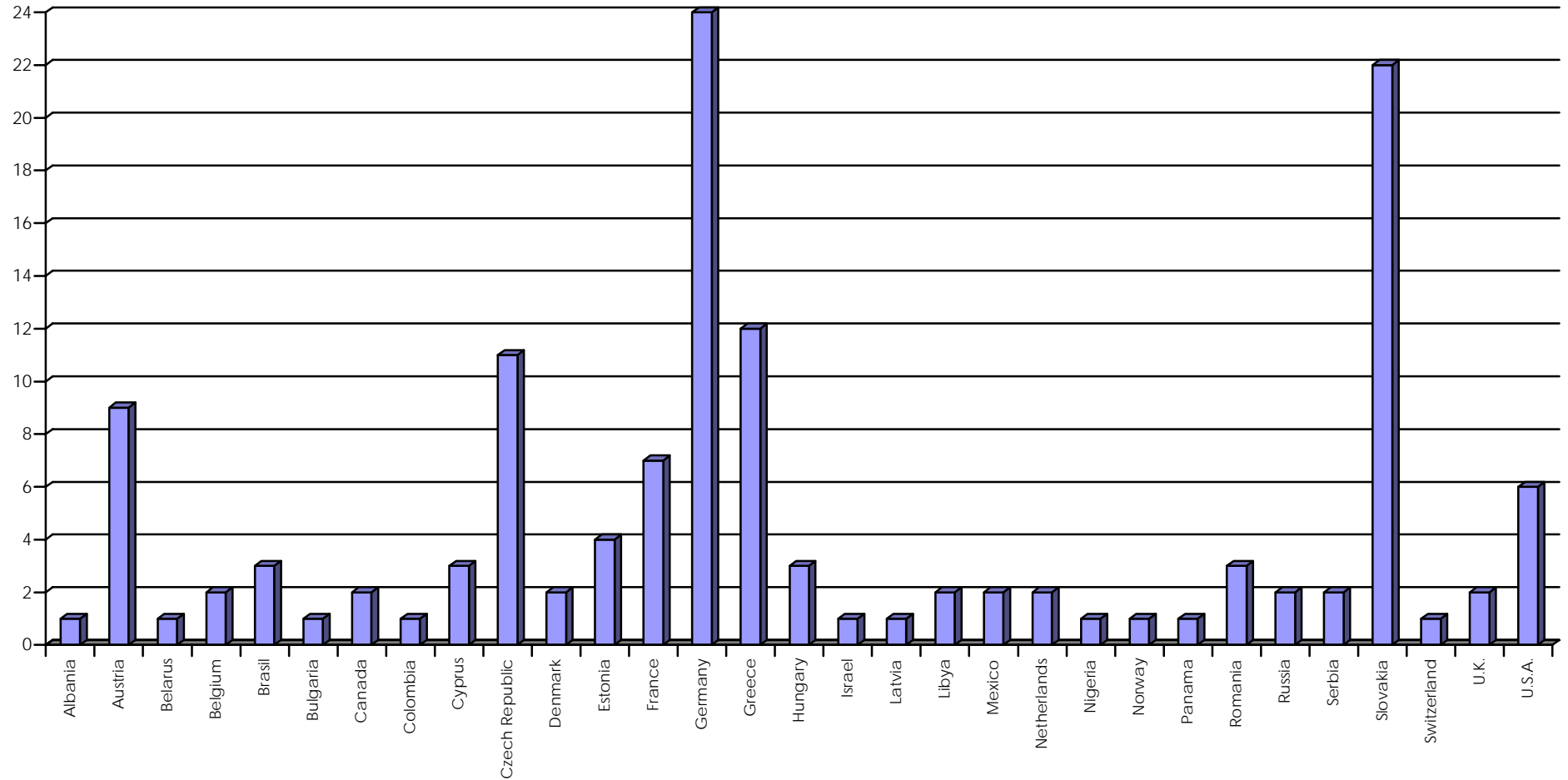
